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## NELSON CITY COUNCIL WATER SUPPLY PRESSURE TEST STATEMENT GUIDELINES

The purpose of the Water Supply Pressure Test Statement is to provide Nelson City Council with a permanent record of pressure test results for the respective building consent. The document also confirms that the plumbing work has been completed, or supervised by a certifying plumber in accordance with the Plumbers Gasfitters and Drainlayers Act 2006.

- a) The pressure test statement is required to be completed by the certifying plumber and issued to Nelson City Council for all water supply installations subject to building consent where the water supply test has not been recorded by a Nelson City Council Building Inspector.
- b) Please ensure that the pressure testing method is specified and attached to this certificate any proprietary brand manufacturers test certificates where manufacturer requires them as part of their quality control regime.
- c) Where a property is serviced by a low pressure or tank supply please describe the test regime used.
